

Top 10 Places to Visit in Richwood

The Richwood Chamber of Commerce & Convention and Visitors Bureau (The Depot) - 38 Edgewood Ave.

Cranberry Tri-Rivers Rail/Trail – Starts at Bridge Avenue.
1.1 mi. from the stop light

Helios Park - On the corner of Edgewood Ave. and Oakford Ave.

Cranberry Campground – Follow Route 39 East for 1 mile from the stop light and turn left on Forest Route 76 – 8.5 miles
Additional information on Backcountry available.

Woodbine - Follow Route 39 East for 1 mile from the stop light and turn left on Forest Route 76 – 8.3 miles

Falls of Hills Creek - Follow Route 39 East for 17.5 miles from the stop light. The Falls are on your right.

Cranberry Glades - Follow Route 39 East 22 miles from the stop light. Turn left onto the Glades road.

Highland Scenic Highway – Follow Route 39 for 23 miles and turn left.

Cranberry Mountain Nature Center – Follow Route 39 East for 23 mi. It is on the right. *Additional information on Backcountry available.*

Nancy Harts Grave - Follow Oakford Avenue South 0.2 mile & turn right at Maple St. Approx. 430 feet, turn slight left at Greenbrier Road. Follow 1.6 mi. and continue on Country Hwy 39/1 several miles to Manning Knob Cemetery. Follow the direction of the sign until you reach the grave.

City Park and Pool, Dain Park and Fishing, Pratt Park & Randolph Falls - Follow the green and white signs in town
